

BURN BANS & FIRE PIT REGULATIONS:

Fire Pits



- ❖ AN OUTDOOR FIRE PIT SHALL BE ENCLOSED ON ALL SIDES AND CONSTRUCTED OF MASONRY, CONCRETE HEAVY GAUGE METAL OR OTHER NON-COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS;
- ❖ THE OUTDOOR FIRE PIT SHALL NOT EXCEED 100 CM IN DEPTH WHEN MEASURED FROM THE BOTTOM OF THE PIT TO THE TOP OF THE PIT OPENING AND SHALL BE AT LEAST 15 CM IN HEIGHT WHEN MEASURED FROM THE SURROUNDING GRADE TO THE TOP OF THE PIT OPENING;
- ❖ THE OUTDOOR FIRE PIT OPENING SHALL NOT EXCEED 107 CM IN DIAMETER OR AN AREA OF 0.89 SQUARE METERS AND THE WIDTH OR LENGTHS SHALL NOT BE GREATER THAN 107 CM;
- ❖ WHEN IN USE, OUTDOOR FIRE PITS SHALL BE CONTINUOUSLY SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT;
- ❖ A MEANS OF EXTINGUISHMENT SUCH AS A PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHER, PAIL OF WATER, SAND OR GARDEN HOSE SHALL BE READILY AVAILABLE ON SITE. ALL FIRES MUST BE COMPLETELY EXTINGUISHED BEFORE LEAVING THE SITE.



Burning Ban:

The Council, by resolution, at their discretion, can ban **OPEN FIRES**, if such fires propose a risk, and such a ban would prevent wildfires from occurring, **OR** can ban **ALL BURNING** in the Rural Municipality of Piney if conditions exist where, in the opinion of the municipality, fires are of extremely high risk, and such a ban would prevent wildfires from occurring.
